- European **education and certification program** for heat pump installers (EUCERT) in AT, BE, DE, SE, FI, FR, UK, SZ, IT (planned)
 - Common training material for heat pump installers
 - Mutual recognition of qualification in participating countries
 - Certification according to EN 17024
- **Project participation** (QualiCert, SEPEMO, Ground-MED, Ground-Reach, Sherpa etc.)
- **Policy monitoring and information dissemination** with stakeholders (MEP)

 - EHPA quality label for heat pumps
 - Available in AT, BE, CH, DE, FI, FR, SE
 - Based on measurements according to EN 14511 in accredited labs
 - Additional requirements: 10 years spare part guarantee, existing service network, installation manual in local language



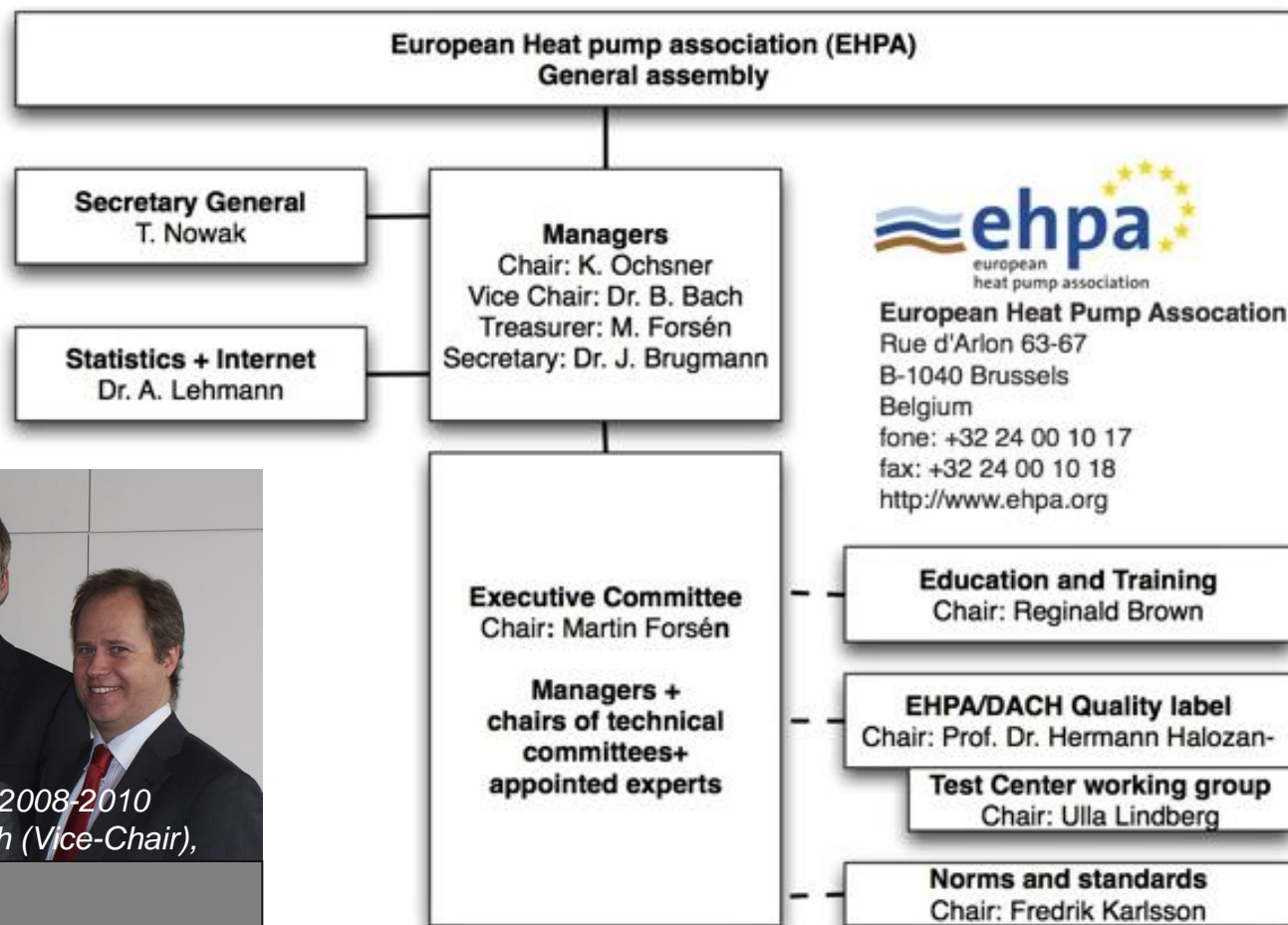
European Heat Pump Association (EHPA) members

EHPA represents the majority of players in the EU heat pump industry!

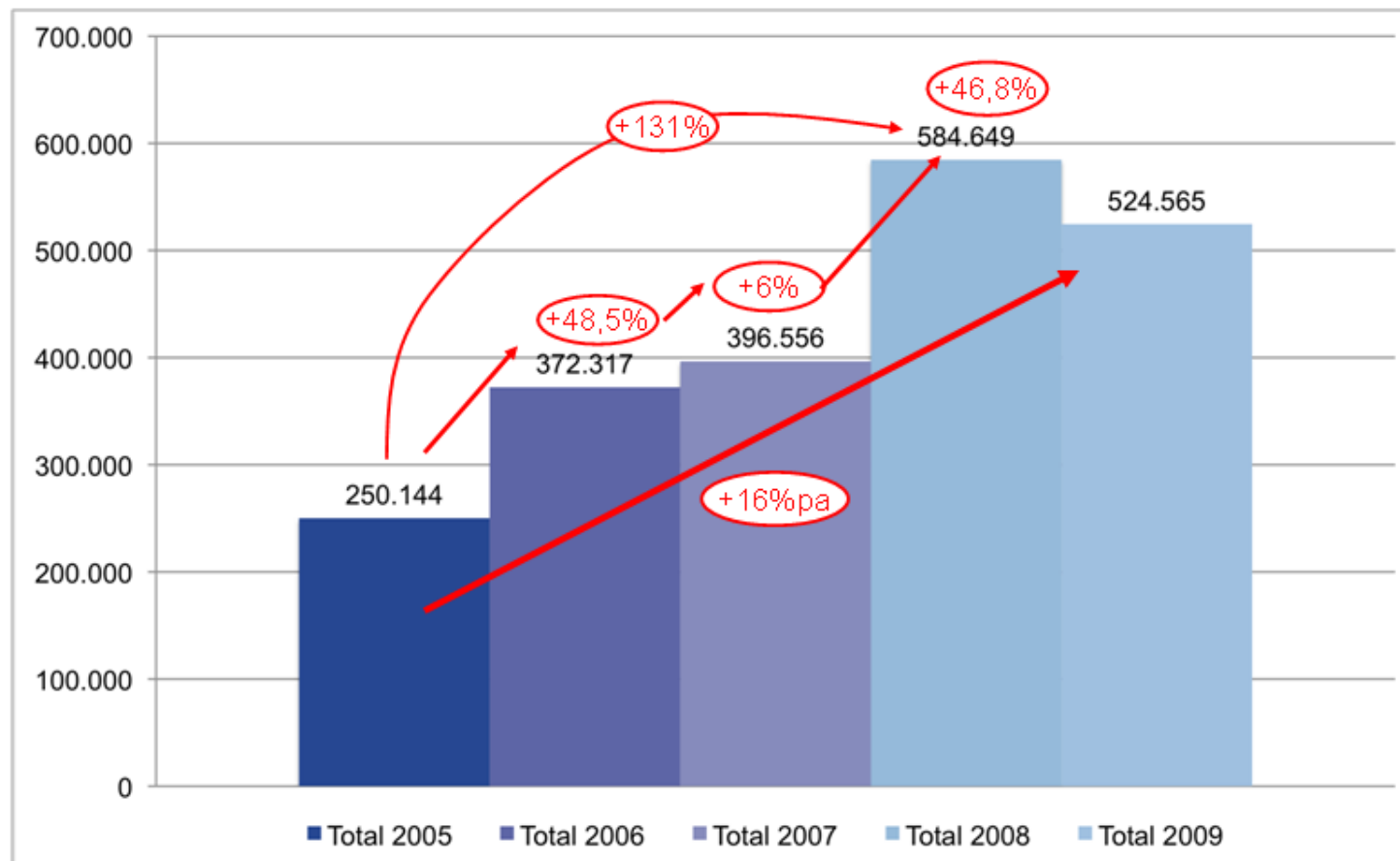


European Heat Pump Association – Organisational structure
